HISTORY AND PURPOSES

This International Adult and Continuing Education Hall of Fame was created not only to honor leaders in the fields of continuing education and adult learning, but to serve as a record and inspiration for the next generation of continuing education leaders.

Election to the Hall of Fame acknowledges that these men and women have made distinguished contributions to the field of adult and continuing education. Each has provided a crucial nexus between resources and learners.

These innovative leaders have believed passionately in the evolutionary power of education. All are themselves exemplary lifelong learners and have left lasting impressions on the students, institutions, and organizations they have served.

A permanent exhibit of plaques honoring each class is on display at The University of Oklahoma campus. Each plaque provides a brief biographical profile and photograph of the inductee.

The Hall of Fame has over 429 members from 45 nations.

INDUCTEE NOMINATIONS

Anyone may nominate a candidate for induction into the International Adult and Continuing Education Hall of Fame. Scholars, practitioners, and policymakers whose primary body of work is related to adult and continuing education are eligible for induction.

Annual inductions are held in conjunction with conferences of associations that represent the profession internationally.

The Hall of Fame strives to rotate induction locations so they are accessible to practitioners throughout the world.



SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The James P. Pappas Scholarship is an annual award made by the Hall of Fame to a graduate student who is majoring in a field related to adult and continuing education. Application forms and deadlines for the scholarship may be found on the Hall of Fame website.
